

Conference Registration:

The registration desk will open on Wednesday Evening, June 5th, at 7:00 p.m. at the Trapp Family Lodge in the Sunroom, adjacent to the Lounge area. The evening registration will be held in conjunction with an Icebreaker Reception. The registration desk will also be open beginning at 7:30 a.m. on Thursday morning.

The pre-conference registration fee is \$150. US (\$240 C) if payment is received by May 31st, 2002. Please pay by US or Canadian check or money order, made payable to the Eastern Snow Conference, and mail to the address on the registration form found below.

The registration fee for payment at the meeting will be \$200 US \$320(C). The Student Registration fee is \$75 (US) or \$120 (C), and does not include the Banquet. Additional banquet tickets can be purchased for \$32 (US) or \$50 (C).
