

EASTERN SNOW CONFERENCE

REPORT OF EQUIPMENT COMMITTEE

The committee made arrangements for the participation of equipment manufacturers at the 33rd meeting. Two companies were represented, respectively Idaho Industrial Instruments Inc., Boise, Idaho (nuclear snow gauges) by Mr. R. Morrison; and Meteorology Research Inc., Altadena, California (weather stations, fog and ice detection equipment) by Mr. R. B. Codling. Hydro-Tech, Seattle, Washington, was unable to show a newly designed compact snow density kit. However, a brochure was available for distribution.

The committee also arranged a display of various snow samplers and cutters which are in use in the Eastern U.S.A. and Canada, through the cooperation of B. Goodison of Atmospheric Environment Service, Toronto. For more details, see item 76-20 of the Research Committee report.
